



A Roman gold ring set with a red jasper intaglio. Bust of Isis-Aphrodite.

The deity is facing right, with her bust partially draped and one breast exposed. On the head, the isiac crown (*solar disc with the horns and feathers*).

Signs of wear and small defects on the setting around the stone.

A syncretic effigy of the Graeco-Roman goddess of Beauty with the attributes of the most important deity of ancient Egypt.
